Executive Nominating Committee

The Nominating Committee has been struck and is hard at work searching for a slate of executives for YOUR organization. I will continue to work with them to find qualified candidates to lead the organization in its 50th anniversary year and beyond.

Ontario Not-for-Profit Corporations Act, 2010 (ONCA)

The Province of Ontario, like the federal government and other provinces, has recently passed legislation to provide a modern, legal framework for how not-for-profit corporations are created, governed and dissolved. The aim of the legislation is to ensure greater transparency and accountability in how not-for-profit corporations in Ontario are run. ALL not-for-profit corporations are affected.

Although the act has passed, the legislation will not take effect until 2014. At that time specific regulations will come into effect and not-for-profit corporations will have three years to comply.

At this point we believe the biggest impact on NFAL is the requirement to revise the by-laws in accordance with the act, which includes ensuring clear accountabilities for director positions. Other changes relate to the annual review of financial results, listing of membership types in the bylaws, use of proxies in carrying out votes, numbers and tenures of directors, and the ability of directors to change



Position	Duties
President	Serves on the Executive. Provides leadership and guidance. Chairs meetings. Writes President's Report for the newsletter and AGM. Keeps up-to-date on all projects. Approves minutes. Is an approver of and has signing authority for banking and official documents. Represents NFAL on all official occasions. Can only serve two, two-year terms. Serves as past-president during full tenure of new president.
First Vice-President	Serves on the Executive. Provides backup for the president. Attends executive meetings and participates in the management of the organization. Responsible for public relations and oversight of communications. Leads/carries out special projects or events, as determined by the executive. Is a signing authority. Assumes presidency at the end of the president's term.
Second Vice-President	Serves on the executive. Coordinates non-executive positions. Responsible for oversight of the NFAL Gallery and liaison with the City of Ottawa. Attends Executive meetings and participates in the management of the organization. Leads/carries out special projects or events, as determined by the executive.
Treasurer	Responsible for financial management of the organization and activities. Prepares and seeks approval for the annual operational budget. Reports on financial results on a quarterly and annual basis, or as requested by the executive. Attends Executive meetings and participates in the management of the organization. Oversees financial budgets and transactions related to NFAL sales. Issues payments for approved/budgeted for expenditures. Carries out banking, reports financial status and on the results of events.
